



ABYRA Wednesday Twilight Season 2004 Notice of Race & Registration

- Race:** Spring series: May 12, 19, 26, June 2, 9, 16
Dates: Summer series: August 11, 18, 25 September 1, 8, 15
- Course:** Various courses on Anchor Bay, starting at CR.
- Start:** 7:00 Warning, 5-minute intervals as defined in ABYRA Handbook and Sailing instruction (refer to RRS 26.1, 01-04)
- Awards:** Class and overall awards presented at ABYRA Haulout Party
- Management:** The regatta shall be managed by the ABYRA Race Committee (RC) and be governed by The *Racing Rules of Sailing* with United States Sailing prescriptions, class rules, The ABYRA Handbook and the Sailing Instructions.
- Classes:** The race is open to all PHRF, One-Design and Cruising (JAM) class boats with a valid DRYA rating. If a boat has no rating, the RC may assign a temporary rating with penalties as it sees fit. Five boats are required for a one-design start. Class splits will be posted at NSSC Wed. May 12th after 1800 hrs.
- Entries:** The ABYRA Race Committee must receive registration no later than Monday, May 10th. Late registration will be accepted subject to a \$10.00 late fee.
- Sailing Instructions:** The ABYRA Handbook including Sailing Instructions available at the Skipper's Meeting on Friday, April 30th, 7:30 pm at NSSC and afterward from an ABYRA Race Committee representative.
- Race Committee Duty:** Participating skippers and at least one crew shall serve race committee duty for one race during the series registered. It is the skipper's responsibility to obtain the date of duty assigned by the ABYRA race committee. R/C duty will be posted on the board at NSSC and at <http://www.warmgear.com>.

It shall be the sole inescapable responsibility of the skipper and crew of the yacht to decide whether or not to start, continue or finish a race. The skipper must assure that all required United States Coast Guard equipment as well as other necessary safety equipment is aboard, properly maintained and stowed, and that the crew know where it is kept and how it is used.
